

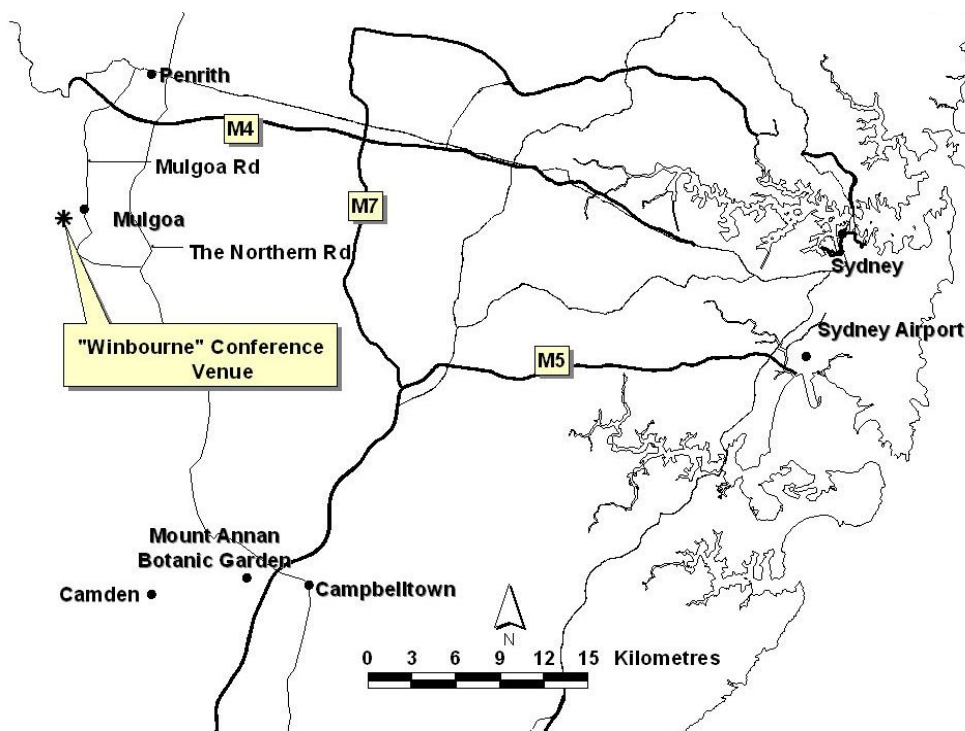
Conference Information

Conference venue

'Winbourne' Edmund Rice Retreat & Conference Centre, 1315 Mulgoa Road, Mulgoa, NSW 2745, is located in western Sydney. The property is set on 250 ha of land originally settled by the Cox family during the 1800's. William Cox was notably associated with building the first road over the Blue Mountains. Unfortunately the original Cox mansion burnt down in 1920 but some of the original buildings are utilised as part of the conference centre along with more recent additions.

Location

'Winbourne' the conference venue is in Mulgoa, 60 km or one hours drive west of Sydney and Sydney Airport. Alternatively it is 15 km or 25 minutes drive from Penrith train station.



How to get to the conference

- 'Winbourne' is best accessed by car and free parking is available at the venue.
- Frequent CityRail train services run frequently from the City to Penrith. However limited connections run from Penrith train station past the conference venue.

Please use the Peppercorn Café at Mulgoa as the destination. Then walk down the conference venue driveway to the right of the Café.
