This will be followed by the combined choir leading the community singing of popular carols like *Deck the Halls, Away in a Manger, Silent Night,* and *Joy to the World.* Santa Claus will also make a guest appearance and lead the choir in singing *Rudolf, Santa Claus is Coming to Town* and other children's favourites.
