

DIAPHOROGRAPHIS

Diaphorographis A.W.Archer & Kalb, in K.Kalb, A.W.Archer, J.Sutjaritturakan & K.Boonpragob, *Biblioth. Lichenol.* 99: 227 (2009), from the Greek *diaphoros* (different) and the genus name *Graphis*.

Type: *D. queenslandica* A.W.Archer & Kalb

Thallus off-white. Ascomata rounded to lirelliform, covered by the thalline margin. Proper exciple thick, completely carbonised. Hymenium not inspersed, I-. Ascospores hyaline, muriform, non-amyloid.

Chemistry: No lichen compounds detected.

A genus of two species, one of which occurs in Australia and New Caledonia, and the other in New Caledonia and the Solomon Islands.

Diaphorographis is distinguished from *Graphis* by its non-amyloid ascospores.
