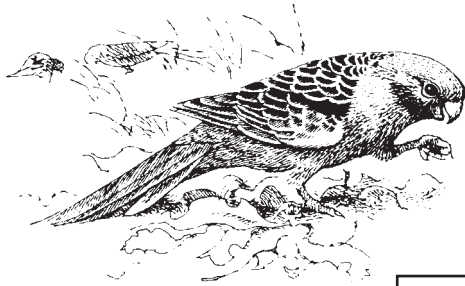

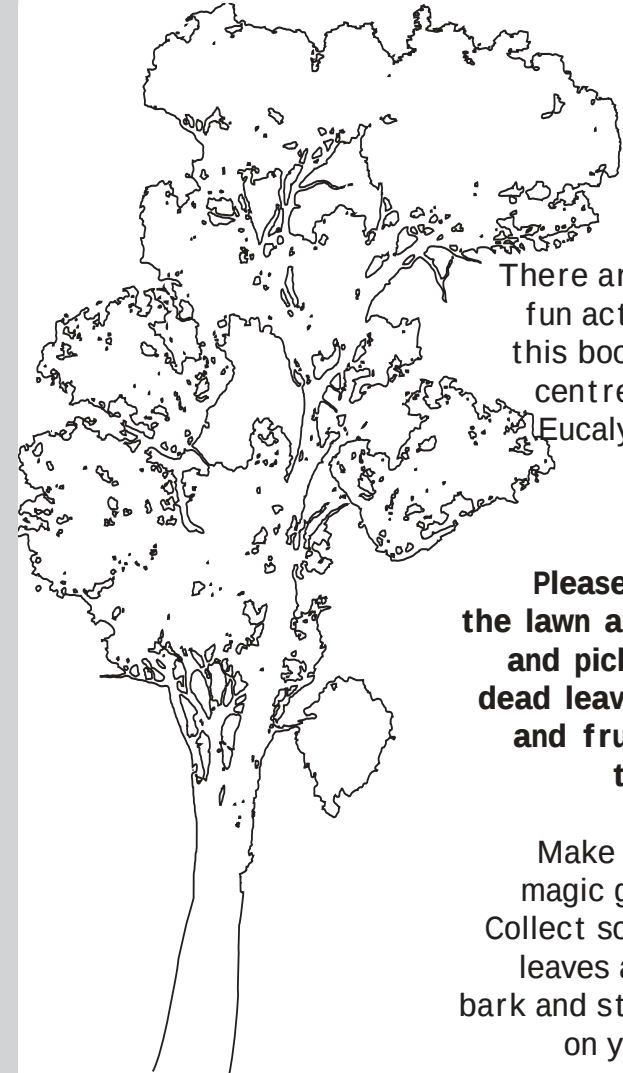

Eucalypt Treasure Hunt

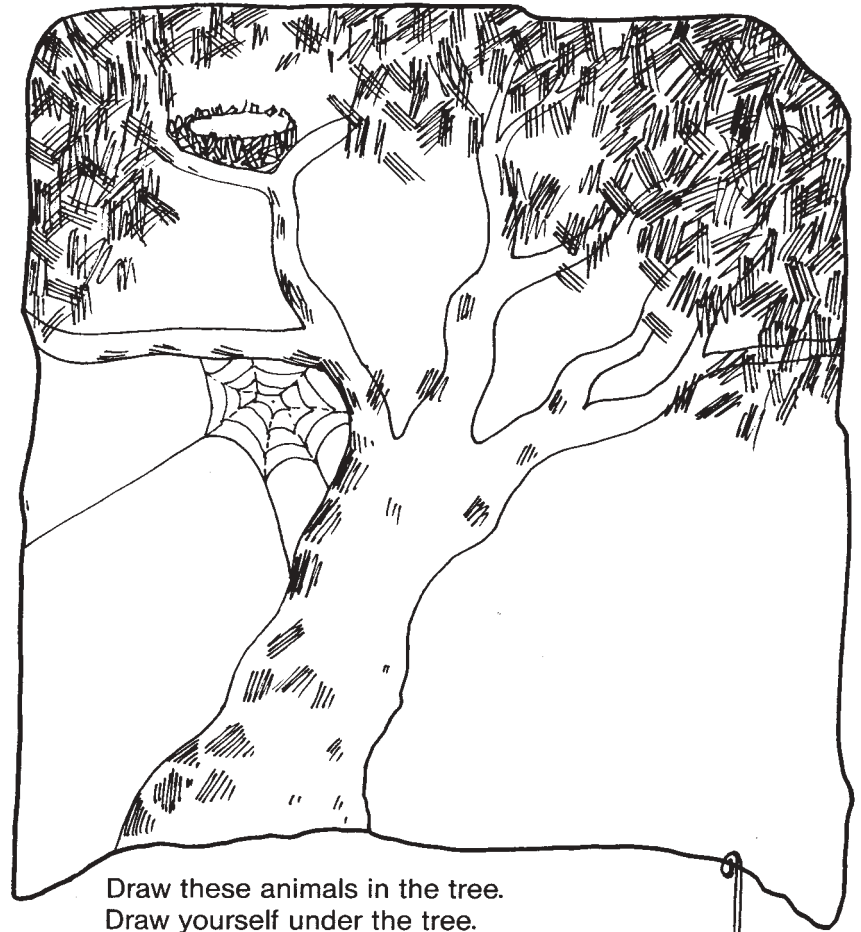
- Collect some gum leaves that are different in shapes and colours. You might like to take them home and trace their outlines.
