Come and see the Australian National Botanic Gardens Nursery. This is a place where all of the plants growing in the Gardens are produced.

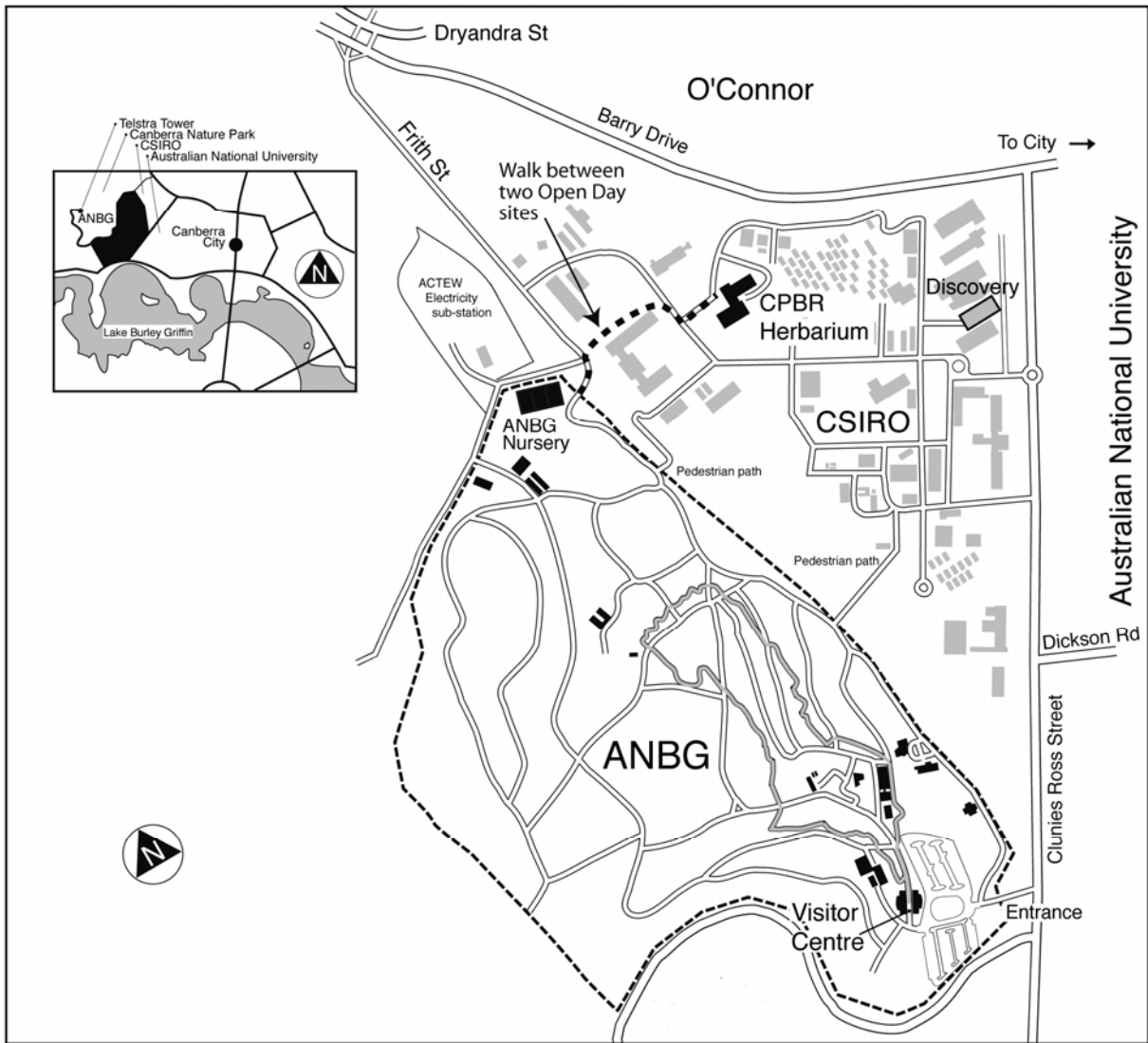
Learn about potting media, our misting houses and plant production methods used behind the scenes at the Australian National Botanic Gardens.

10.00 am to 3.00 pm

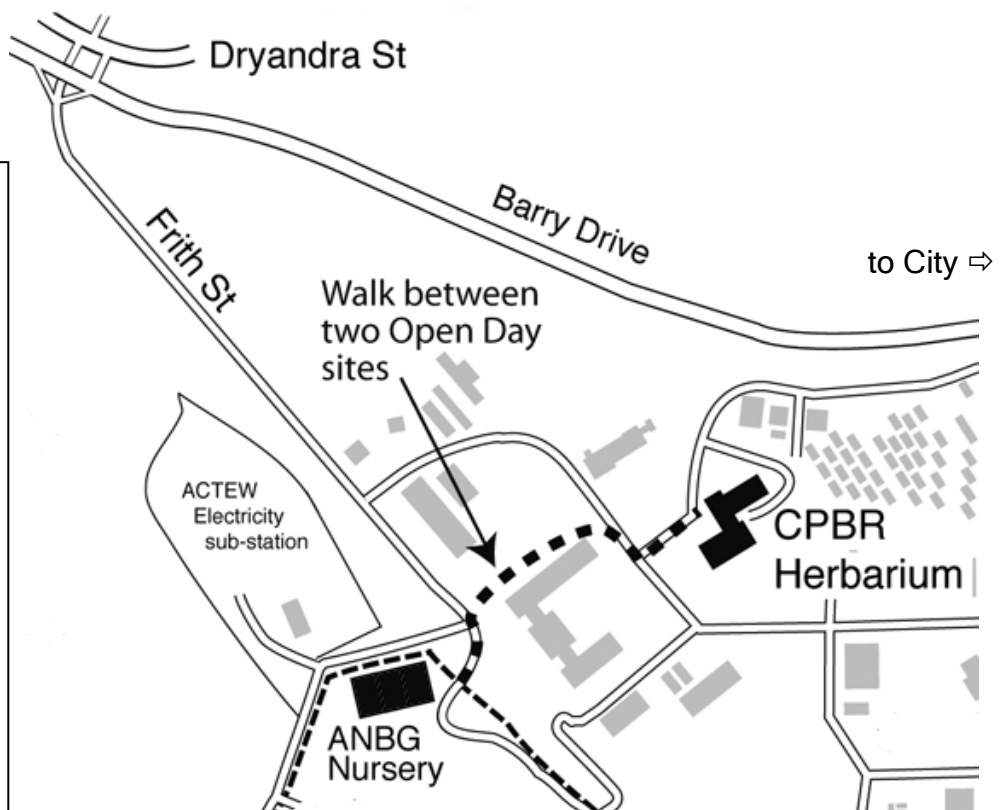
Nursery staff will be conducting tours on the hour at 10am, 11am, 12pm, 1pm and 2pm.

Getting there

From the City to Belconnen along Barry Drive, turn left into Frith Street just past CSIRO.

From Belconnen to City along Barry Dr, turn left into Dryandra St, then left and left to go under Barry Drive into Frith Street.

Parking
